- 1.1 Must be a residential of Danielskuil Town or within 200kms radius.
- 1.2 The main criteria for the selection of applications are financial need and academic potential.
- 1.3 Bursary applications are invited from young people who aim to study full time towards an undergraduate university (academic) degree in Chemistry, Mining or Engineering etc.
- 1.4 Applicants must have registered at a South African public institution of higher learning of their choice by the time the bursary is awarded.
- 1.5 Preference will be given to applicants from designated groups.

- 2.1 Applications **will only be considered if completed in full** and signed by the applicant and if all the supporting documents have been included.
- 2.2 Documents that accompany the application form must be certified (see checklist **below**).
